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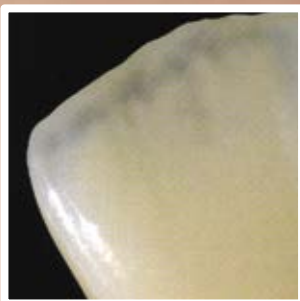

On to pumpkins, school, football and leaves. Once again time for the ODA Annual Session. I often mark the passing of years by this event because it feels like a sprint through summer and then ODA signals the start of the transition into the beginning of the dark and often dreary time of year.

Many of you may know, my kids are young. While it may seem we are losing the fight with third-party insurance from a reimbursement perspective, the fact is, regardless of what an insurance company pays for a procedure, we must focus on the patient's needs. It's challenging to

work outside of the realm of insurance, with yearly limits, co-insurance, deductibles and basic vs. major coverage. However, we owe it to our patients to focus on their needs, treating active disease, preventing infections or emergencies while also listening to the actual patient's desires for their dental health and appearance.

In complex patients, it is never a sprint. Those are the cases I love the most. Slow it down. One step at a time. Watching somebody who has neglected their dental health for years, they take what I say seriously, follow the guidance of my team and treatment plan; then to see them come out the other side in so much better shape, there's nothing like it. It's amazing that we can do that! It's amazing that we get to do that! Insurance can't touch that. Sometimes, it's simply taking the insurance piece out of the equation for the patient, and for yourself that liberates you from treating a simple problem like a cavity, and shifts it to treating a person. Sure, insurance is a headache. But if you find the joy in helping the person again, it seems like a blip on the radar. We can slow it down in our practice, for the betterment of our psyche, our patient and our staff, and in that moment, we can control it.

As far as slowing down time and controlling life outside of those moments, I have yet to find the answer, but I'm working on it daily. And who says dentists are control freaks ;-). Have a great fall everyone, and as always, if you need anything dental related or not, please reach out anytime.

The April Council Meeting Minutes were unanimously approved as posted.

**President's Report: Dr. Christopher Heck**

The five main goals developed by the Strategic Planning Task Force (**recruitment/retention; finance and non-dues revenue; leadership/development; CE; marketing**) were discussed and approved (Bennet/Khetarpal). Status updates for each goal will be discussed at the December Council meeting (Bennet/Dorr). All Council members are encouraged to participate in expanding one or more of the outlined goals.

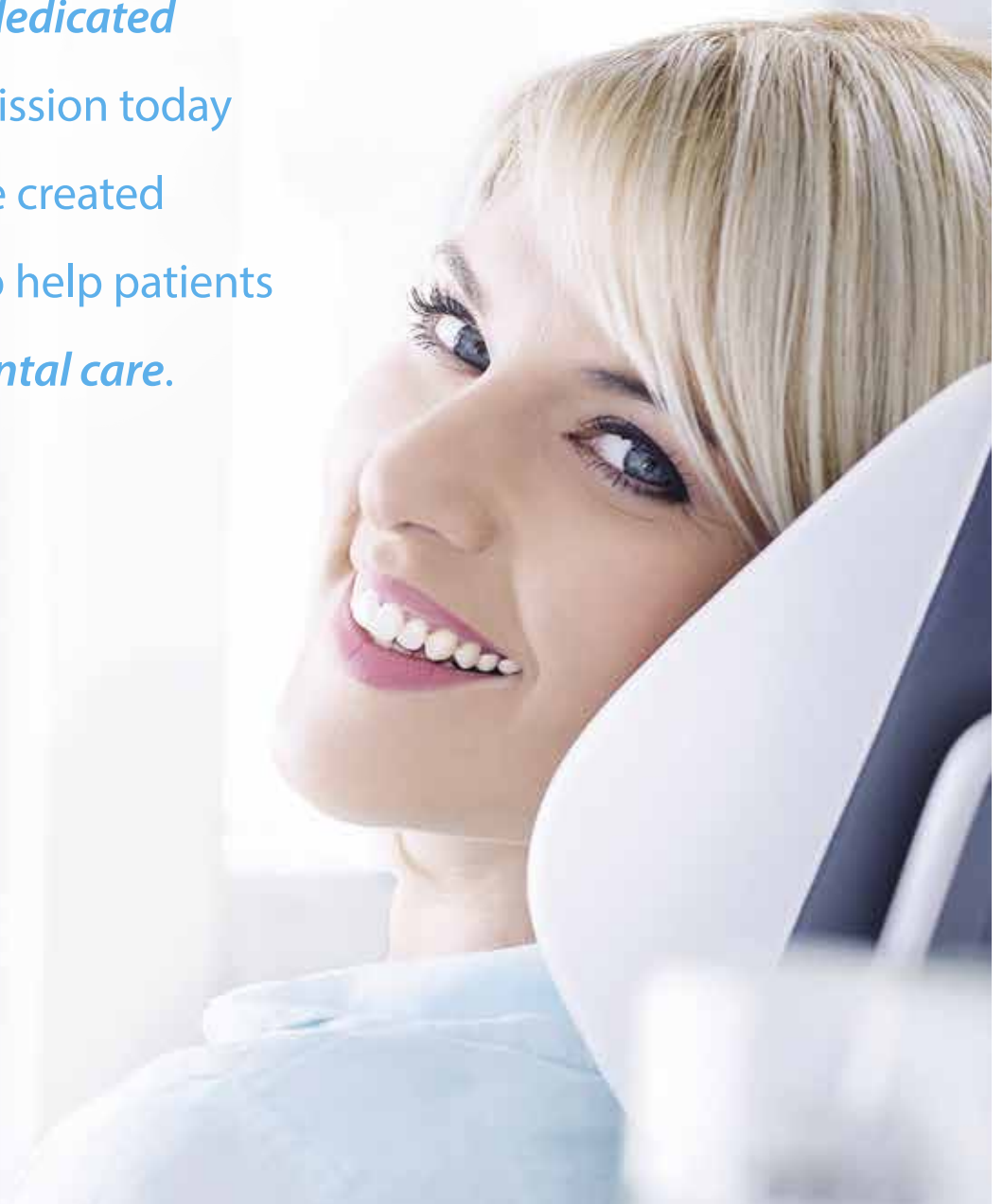

### **First Course Description**

This course will teach you how to recognize the signs of gastric esophageal reflux, bulimia, tooth paste, acidic beverages (energy drinks and soda), acidic foods, and bruxism. During the course you will gain the foundational skills to recognize, prevent, and treat patients who are experiencing enamel and dentinal wear caused by erosion and/or bruxism. (Prevention, Direct, Indirect)

At the end of the course participants will:

- Be able to identify the cause(s) of tooth wear
- Have gained an understanding of preventive strategies
- Understand restorative strategies in a non-favorable oral environment

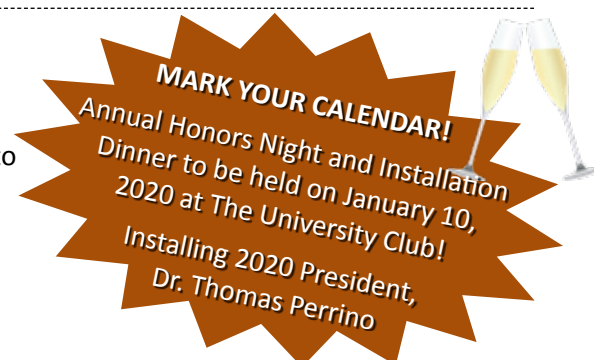

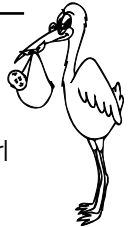

## Posterior Composites: A Rapid, Simplified Placement Technique by Ronald Jackson, DDS on Thursday, December 12, 2019

### **Course Description**

Posterior composite resin restorations have become mainstream. These restorations seal teeth, reinforce remaining tooth structure, allow conservative preparations and satisfy patient desires for natural appearance. However, dentists complain that Class II composite restorations are exacting, tedious, time consuming, somewhat complicated, and aren't always predictable. In addition, clinicians can sometimes be confused by the vast choice of adhesives in the marketplace, all claiming to be the best, and report frustration whenever a Class II contact is to light or missed altogether.

In this presentation, Dr. Jackson will show a greatly simplified and efficient procedure for placing posterior composite restorations based on new materials and technology. In addition, the predictable, standardized protocol results in a significant reduction in both time and effort when placing these restorations.

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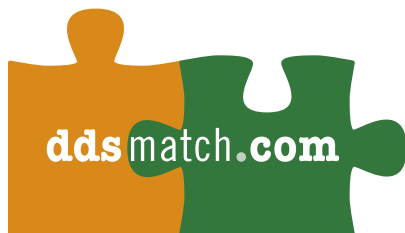
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## Past President's Dinner Highlights October 17, 2019 at Cooper's Hawk in Kenwood

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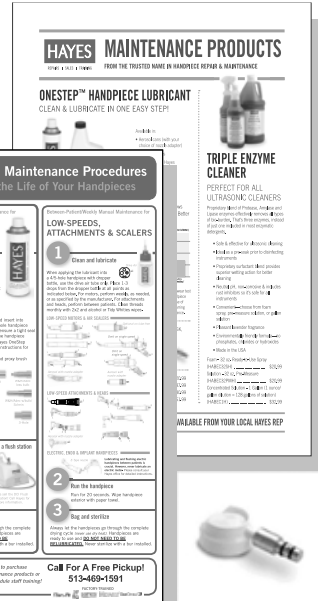
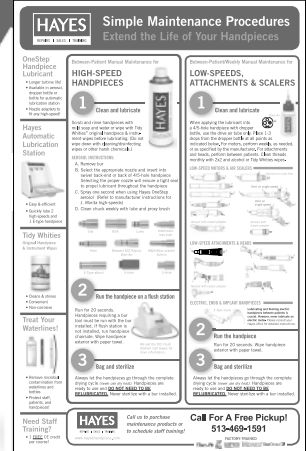
